2024 RULES

J&R Refrigeration and Reef Print & Design Social Series

"Played in memory of Raymond Johnson"

1. Social Series

- 1.1. The social series will include eight (8) daily events.
- 1.2. The series draw will be controlled by the Director only.
- 1.3. Changes to the draw will be controlled by the Director only, changes may accommodate for,
 - 1.3.1. Weather conditions
 - 1.3.2. Golf course closures
 - 1.3.3. Golf course availability
- 1.4. A once off nomination fee of \$50.00 must be paid prior to the competitors first round to be eligible to accumulate Order of Merit points.
- 1.5. Non-GA players are eligible to play for daily prizes and will be allocated a handicap by the director, this will be either their last known GA handicap, their social club handicap or a maximum handicap of eighteen (18) if they have never held a GA handicap previously.
- 1.6. Non-GA players must have recorded a minimum of three (3) x cards and registered for a golflink number prior to accumulating Order of Merit points.
- 1.7. Order of Merit points are calculated using the scoring system listed,
 - 1.7.1. Daily event winner $(1^{st}) = 20$ points
 - 1.7.2. Daily event second place $(2^{nd}) = 15$ points
 - 1.7.3. Daily event third place $(3^{rd}) = 10$ points
 - 1.7.4. Daily event participation = 5 points
- 1.8. In the situation of a tie,
 - 1.8.1. The equal leaders must be present on the final round to be eligible.
 - 1.8.2. A count back will be performed in the following sequence,
 - 1.8.2.1. Most wins (1st place) for the season
 - 1.8.2.2. Most seconds (2^{nd} place) for the season
 - 1.8.2.3. Most thirds (3rd place) for the season
 - 1.8.3. If a winner still can't be determined, a play off on the eighteenth (18th) hole will take place, winner determined by the best stableford points recorded.

2. Daily Events

- 2.1. Daily events will be played as a single stableford scoring format.
- 2.2. Scores will be recorded through the golf genius app, in the situation a score card is used, it must be signed by both player and marker and submitted to the Director.
- 2.3. Handicaps are calculated off GA and adjusted by the daily slope rating.
- 2.4. Non-GA players are eligible to play for daily prizes and will be allocated a handicap by the director, this will be either their last known GA handicap, their social club handicap or a maximum handicap of eighteen (18) if they have never held a GA handicap previously.
- 2.5. In the situation of a tie,
 - 2.5.1. A count back will be performed in the following sequence,
 - 2.5.1.1. Best back nine (9) holes points
 - 2.5.1.2. Best last six (6) holes points
 - 2.5.1.3. Best last three (3) holes points
 - 2.5.1.4. Best last hole (18th hole) points

3. Overall

- 3.1. Non-GA social series handicaps will be controlled by the Director and adjustments will be made relevant to the scores that have been submitted.
- 3.2. Local golf club rules must be adhered to at all times.
- 3.3. Rulings and disputes will be settled by the Director and/or golf club officials.
- 3.4. If at any time the social series rules are not followed, a player may be disqualified at the discretion of the Director.
